MOON PHILLY vied for the early lead, then dropped back and raced three wide and gained command on the second turn then was ridden out to the wire. QUEEN'S RULE was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. NEO'S GRAND FINALE vied for the lead from along the inside, then weakened on the second turn. SECRET LONGING was close up early, raced along the three path on the second turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. WEEPER vied for the lead from the two path into the far turn, then faded late. FOR REAL TOO vied for the lead then dropped back early and was not a threat. CARPE PRETIUM was through early, raced two wide on the far turn and was outrun.
