NINETY FIVE SOUTH stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then rallied from the outside and drew off under mild encouragement. STRATEGIC MOVE set the pace from the start, held a clear lead and saved ground through the turn, then was outfinished late. BROTHER IN ARMS pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, angled to the inside in the stretch but lacked a late response. MISFIT MANNY was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, the lacked a rally late. SWEETCANDYMAN was slow early, raced along the two path on the turn, then showed little. KASH KOW KAZ was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then faltered and was outrun in the stretch.
