MYTHIC APPEAL steadied in tight midway on the backstretch then angled outside, moved two wide to command just before a half, was clear in early stretch then widened under urging. BECAUSE OF ME took command at once, angled to the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, drifted entering the final furlong and weakened. THICKET raced two wide and gained mildly. RUN MOMMY RUN was slow from the gate, stayed inside and found best stride too late. BELL'S ROYAL MISS raced two wide around the turn and failed to menace. PRINCESS MEDORA wasn't far back early, angled to the rail on the turn then stopped and was eased up late. NOUVELLE ORLEANS was outrun. CATANGELIC was finished early.
