MISS SUGARMAGNOLIA was rated two wide in good position, moved to vie on the final turn and drew clear late. QUIET WAVE made the early pace two wide, angled to the inside once clear on the final turn then gave way late. SANDRA LA BELLE stayed out from the inside while unhurried then outlasted the others. ONE SWEET BANKER was slow to settle then passed tired ones. ORIENT SKY came out on the first turn, was wide around the final turn and stopped. STAY CLEAR ran inside the early leader to the far turn then stopped. PASS THE BLUSH showed little.
