Footnotes

ROYAL STYLIST was never far back, raced along the two path on the last turn, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. GERONI vied for the lead from the start, raced inside through the far turn, then was outfinished after a long drive. LUKE'S FLASH was close up from the start, raced three wide on the last turn, then finished well. SPIKEAVELLIAN was close up and four wide while contending on the last turn, then weakened from those efforts. GROOVY KID pressed the early pace, contended while along the inside, then tired in the stretch. FOOLISH BID was slow early, raced four wide on the last turn and was not a threat. WISCONSIN lacked speed while saving ground and showed little throughout. MOUNT WEATHER vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the second turn then flattened out.
