LISTEN IN stalked the pace from the two path on the turn, then gained command and finished under urging. BEIJIN was never far back, raced inside at the 1/4 pole, then made a mild bid late and held place. JACKIE'S EXPRESS was close up early, saved ground on the turn and found her best stride late. PICABO'S CONCHO showed good early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then weakened late. RED BANDERA vied for the early lead from along the inside, gained an advantage on the turn, then faded in the drive. ECLIPTICALS WHISKY raced along the two path on the turn and was never a threat. LOVABULL ME vied for the early lead, raced along the two path through the turn, then flattened out in the stretch. YOU NEED ME was through early and outrun.
