**Footnotes**

LATE IN THE DAY set the pace from the start, was headed on the backstretch then drew off late and finished under urging. DAYBREAK EXPRESS was never far back, raced inside on the last turn, then closed ground willingly. LANSDOWN STREET pressed the pace from the three path through the second turn, then weakened late. JOHNNY MAESTRO stalked the pace from the start, raced two wide through the far turn, then tired from those early efforts. ROMAN SCORPION was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. DOUBLE DEJA VU was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn then faded in the stretch. ONE LESS AFFAIR raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. WANTED SONG lacked speed but passed the tired ones. SONSAM saved ground but showed little. RADETSKY SALUTE pressed the early pace then faded on the backstretch. IRUNTHISPLACE was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn then faltered and was outrun. FLYNNSTONE lacked speed and pulled up early.
