KINGS VILLAGE was rated inside in good position, was shuffled back entering the far turn, rallied to a clear lead past midstretch then lasted. POWERS OFTHE COURT was unhurried while out from the rail, rallied wide around the final turn, closed outside and missed. BASCOM HALL was never far back, moved two wide to command entering the far turn then gave way after a mile. CHASE THE UNKNOWN was unhurried, lodged a four wide bid midway on the final and had nothing left for the drive. SINATRA'S PRINCE was unhurried while caught wide around the first turn, bid three wide between horses on the final turn then tired. YESTERDAY'S STORY lagged early then made a late run inside. J P'S FLING set or forced the pace two wide into the far turn then tired. INSCRUTABLE dueled outside to the far turn then tired. ITTAI was outrun. YOU FUNNY stopped and was eased up late.
