Footnotes

BEAN was unhurried early, raced two wide on the turn, then angled out and drew off late while under urging. KING'S SOLDIER was close up from the start and two wide through the turn while racing evenly throughout. HOUSE OF BOO vied for the lead from the three path into the turn, then weakened late. GRANTS GOLD was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. READ MY TALE was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn, then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. SEISMOGRAPH vied for the early lead from the two path, then faded late. KAZ CITY failed to menace. MY BABY T pressed the pace from the inside through the turn, then faltered late. TAKE A STAR saved ground but was not a threat. C FOUR lacked speed and was outrun.
