### Footnotes

OUR PRIZE was rated outside with the pace following an alert break, moved three wide to command early on the turn and drew out under urging. GLOBAL RISK was unhurried inside, angled out leaving the turn then split horses in the lane and was clear for the place. SUDDEN CALM was slow to settle, rallied four wide around the turn and gained some ground late. SOUTHERN PRIZE was unhurried, was sent closer four wide on the turn then flattened out. VICTOR'S TUITION moved to a short lead from between horses midway on the backstretch, raced two wide around the turn and tired. KING OF THE FAERY angled to the inside while with the early leaders and tired in the lane. HUNTER was steadied nearing and into the stretch and failed to menace. HERSHYSLITETHEPOWR wasn't far back between horses early, angled to the rail on the turn and tired. NACHITO was outrun after a slow break. ECSTATIC DREAMER made the early pace then stopped.
