**Footnotes**

PROWERS COUNTY was never far back, raced two wide around the turn, the rider dropped his whip in deep stretch and was clear at the end. ITSANOTHERMINISTER moved to a short lead from the outside early on the turn, moved clear in early stretch then faltered. ALBERT'S TIGER was shuffled back after the break then was unhurried, rallied out from the rail around the turn, steadied then angled out entering the final furlong and finished full of run. SEMESTER weakened inside. EL CHIVO was clear after going a furlong, stayed out from the inside and tired. SAND DEVIL raced two wide and failed to menace. ENVY THIS BULL was outrun inside. ONE LES TRICK was outrun two wide. GREAT NITE stayed well out from the inside and tired. BIG RED SKY was outrun three wide. GOOD MAN JACK raced four wide around the turn and stopped. CHAMPAGNE BLUES ducked in sharply leaving the gate then trailed.
