THIRD AND LONG stayed out from the rail once clear on the turn and held under urging. ANGEL'S CLASH was slow from the gate, swung five wide into the stretch and finished fast. TAIF chased from the three path then weakened. MR. COMMISSIONER raced three wide into the stretch and finished willingly between horses. SNUCKINTHEFOREST stayed off the rail and lacked a rally. PHOR PHILIPPE lagged out from the rail into the stretch then made up ground. LION'S PRIDE was shut off when trying to split horses entering the stretch. GAARA tired inside.
