RAFFIE'S BANDIT was unhurried early, saved ground to the far turn, then angled to the three path mid turn and drew off while under mild encouragement. NAIF was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. MY SEBY was close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn then made a mild bid in the stretch. YIELD AT THE BULL was also close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then passed tired ones late. FIVE STAR RATING vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide on the second turn, then flattened out in the lane. STAR ISABELLA vied for the lead from the inside to the second turn then faltered. WEST IS BEST lacked speed, saved ground on the far turn and showed little throughout. MONKEY MAN saved ground but trailed.
