LUSTERDUST was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then reached contention in mid stretch and prevailed at the wire. TOCSETS DANCER was also unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn, contended in mid stretch and just missed. KING KOBE was slow early, raced two wide through the last turn, then made a mild bid late. ECHSTEIN VILLAGE raced in the second flight on the backstretch, was three wide on the far turn, then lacked a late response. CHAMPLEVE pressed the early pace, raced two wide and gained command on the last turn, then faltered from early efforts. FLYING POWER lacked speed, saved ground on the last turn and showed little throughout. BULLY AROUND set the pace from the start, held a clear lead and raced inside to the far turn then flattened out. PROUD TIGER was through early and outrun.
