TOOT Z ROLL stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then gained command in the stretch and drew off under mild encouragement. BUNNY BLIZZARD pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, made a late bid but was no match for the winner. SLIPSTITCH was slow early, raced four wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. ECHO CENTER was close up early, saved ground on the turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. LUDUS MAGNUS vied for the early lead, raced along the three path on the turn, then gave way in the stretch. SUPER QUEEN was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then found her best stride late. BARCAZA raced along the inside on the turn but failed to menace. PERFIDIA was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then was through after a half. LADYLUCK vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then faltered and was outrun.
