ZIPPITY GOOMBA was rated three wide with the pace, moved to command before a half, was clear in early stretch then widened under brisk urging. STARKERS wasn't far back outside, was sent three wide into the stretch, gave her best into the final furlong then flattened out. OUR QUIET DANCER stayed out from the inside and weakened in the lane. SUNNY SORTIE stayed well out from the rail and passed tired ones. MORE HEROICS ducked in sharply leaving the gate, raced wide around the turn and was outrun. GO FOR C AND K was outrun after a slow break. MISS BLACK ICE made the early pace inside, was asked for her best on the turn and stopped. FOX WORTHY angled to the rail entering the turn and stopped. STEEL BAY pressed the pace two wide to the stretch then stopped. WIDOW'S JEWEL ducked out at the break then angled to the rail, steadied and came out sharply entering the turn and stopped.
