MISS SOUFLE was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then moved out five wide in the stretch and rallied to be up in the final strides. COMBAT AFFAIR pressed the pace from the start, raced along the inside throughout, took a late lead but just missed. CORDON NEGRO trailed on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and closed willingly. LUNAR SONATA stalked the pace into the turn from the four path, reached contention in mid stretch then weakened. PENSIVE LADY was never far back, raced five wide in the turn then moved out six wide in the stretch while making a good effort. SOUTHERN SHADE vied for the lead from the start, racing off the rail on the turn but gave way in mid stretch. CRYSTAL PREDICTION vied for the lead from along the inside then faded late.
