MATTER OF RECORD was rated, rallied three wide then closed a gap in the final yards. NOBLE KING cleared then angled to the inside on the turn and gave way late. BID FROM BOURTAI came out in early stretch and finished willingly. CONFIRMONDI pressed two wide then weakened. KING MONGO stayed well out from the inside and made up ground too late. H F MANIX showed speed between horses, angled to the inside on the turn then weakened. WARRIOR RUN was outrun. LAYTON was outrun after a slow break. TOO RISKY fell far back early.
