COFFEE BREAK was unhurried, began a run three wide into the far turn, swung wide into the stretch, took over nearing the final sixteenth then drew clear under urging. IMPERIAL ORDER settled inside, came out for the drive and finished with good energy. HOT RODDER pressed two wide, gained command early on the far turn then faltered. NICETOSEY'AGAIN angled to the inside while not far back on the backstretch then lacked a closing response. CHILL WIND made the pace along the rail to the far turn then tired. T. T.'S POINT was caught wide around both turns, offered a mild run on the final turn then weakened. SENATOR wasn't far back between horses into the far turn then tired. CAPE GIRARDEAU lagged badly early. AGENT OF CHAOS steadied in tight between horses entering the far turn then stopped.
