**Footnotes**

JETTIES BEACH was unhurried, rallied three wide around the final turn, took over from between horses leaving the furlong grounds and held. ROYAL IGNITION was slow early, rallied wide around the final turn, vied outside the winner into the final furlong but wasn't enough. TREATY NOTICE was unhurried, rallied three wide between rivals into the stretch, angled to the inside and gained to the end. ADIRONDACK DEW was slow early, raced well out from the inside around the final turn and finished willingly outside. IZZY'S LITTLE FOOT had early position between horses, moved two wide to command early on the far turn then weakened in the lane. LAST LORD was slow to find best stride. OKEECHOBEE wasn't far back outside, moved to vie three wide on the final turn then stopped. WHY WHY WISH stopped inside. MAYFEVER was outrun inside. MAGIC CHANCE moved to a clear early lead inside, made the way into the far turn then stopped. ALYSUNSAFFAIR was outrun.
