WHOOPSIE set the pace from the two path through the turn, held a clear lead to mid stretch then just lasted while under urging. GYPSY TRAVELER was never far back, raced two wide on the turn then angled outward and closed ground fast and just missed. ELECTRIC EMILY was close up, raced two wide on the turn, then finished evenly. SHAYE APPEAL was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then failed to sustain her bid. TRUST YOU stalked the pace early, raced along the inside on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. LA ALTAGRACIA saved ground but trailed throughout.
