### Footnotes

DEFEET R FLEET stalked the pace from the three path through the far turn, then rallied in the stretch and drew off while under steady urging. MALIBU MURMUR pressed the early pace from the two path, reached contention on the far turn, then entered into a long drive and finished second best. HELLO was never far back, raced four wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. MAGNIFICENT IMAGE was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. SULLY'S APPROACH lacked speed, saved ground on the last turn and showed little throughout. ELBA set the pace from the start, held a clear lead on the backstretch, the was headed and flattened out.
