Footnotes

SUMMER'S LULLABY was unhurried early, raced three wide at the 1/4 pole, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. MANHUNT pressed the pace from the three path through the far turn, then drew clear but was outfinished late. CRANBERRY LAKE was close up and three wide on the far turn then made a mild bid. SHESAHOTTAMMLE pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the second turn then weakened. ELEGANT PARADOX stalked the early pace, raced inside on the far turn and reached contention, then tired in the drive. KING OF THE CATS set the pace early, was headed on the backstretch, then faded in the stretch. RHYTHM DOWN BELOW trailed the field.
