**Footnotes**

HELPING HAND set the pace from the start then drew off to a clear lead early, saved ground through the last turn, then was ridden out to the wire. NO INFLATION pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide through the second turn, then lacked a late gain and finished second best. FIERY FOREST was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then lacked a late response. PARABOLA was void of early speed, saved ground on the last turn but lacked a rally. SURPRISE STORM pressed the early pace, saved ground on the far turn, then faded in the stretch. STRAIGHT THUNDER was through after a half, raced along the three path on the far turn and was outrun.
