FLYING POWER was rated inside, rallied four wide to command just after six furlongs then drew out under urging. UNCEASING was never far back, moved two wide to command early on the far turn then couldn't stay with the winner through the lane. EXTRA HONOR wasn't far back along the rail for over six furlongs then tired. TWITTER MACHINE wasn't far back early, gave his best three wide on the final turn then stopped. GO PA was outrun. FANTASTIC OMEN cleared soon after the break, stayed out from the inside while making the way into the far turn then stopped.
