UNIVERSAL SOUL stalked the pace from the inside, contended early then drew clear on the last turn and finished under urging. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE was unhurried early, raced inside on the second turn, then closed ground willingly. ASK OMMADON was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn and advanced steadily throughout. ALINA'S LAD pressed the pace from the start, reached contention on the backstretch then gave way late. BATTLEGROUND was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then lacked a late response. KIM'S DIXIE TUNE was void of early speed, raced two wide on the second turn and failed to menace. SWEAT SHOP was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn and failed to sustain his bid. GOOD TO BE ME vied for the lead early, raced two wide on the last turn then flattened out.
