**Footnotes**

HERMAN'S SOLDIER stalked the pace from the three path through the second turn, reached contention late then drew off under urging. REPRISSE pressed the pace from the inside, gained command on the second turn, then was outfinished in the final yards. ALYSUNSAFFAIR was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then closed willingly. DREAM HOLIDAY set the pace early, was headed on the backstretch, raced two wide through the second turn and gave way in the lane. LANGARTIC was void of early speed, raced two wide on the last turn, then found his best stride late. ONE HUNDRED LAUGHS was close up early, saved ground on the last turn but lacked a rally. SHEPHERD ONE pressed the pace and reached contention early, raced three wide on the second turn and faded in the late going. BIRTHDAY HAT raced three wide on the second turn and failed to menace. STARBAY lacked speed and was outrun. DRUMS pressed the early pace while saving ground, then faltered on the second turn and was outdistanced.
