KEYSTONE DADDY took over shortly after the break, raced two wide around the turn, drew out in early stretch and held under steady urging. REVERE wasn't far back while three wide between horses around the turn but couldn't gain. UNDRGROUNDREGULATR moved up wide on the turn but lacked a strong closing response. ELTHAM raced inside the winner to the stretch then weakened. HOT NECKER was slow early, raced wide around the turn and gained mildly. THREE FOR TWO was content to lag following a slow break, swung wide into the stretch and made up ground outside. BIOHAZZARD angled to the rail while slow early and failed to menace. AFLEET AHEAD showed speed between horses to the turn, edged out nearing the stretch then tired.
