BEANSNTATERS was never far back, raced two wide on the far turn, then reached contention in the stretch and prevailed at the wire. MADDISONS PASSION set the pace from the start, held a clear lead while saving ground through the last turn, then was headed in mid stretch and gave way late. CHASE THE UNKNOWN was close up and two wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. BUH BUH BUH BENNY was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then made a mild bid late. LOCOMOTION LOUIE was close up early, raced two wide and dropped back on the far turn. THRILL FACTOR pressed the pace from the start, raced along the inside on the last turn, then faltered late. WALMER LODGE was close up and wide early, then angled to the inside on the second turn, faded in the stretch and was outrun.
