YESTERDAY'S STORY was unhurried early, raced four wide on the last turn, then closed ground fast in the stretch and drew off under urging. SINATRA'S PRINCE pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide on the second turn, reached contention in mid stretch then was outfinished. UNCLE HARRY was void of early speed, raced three wide on the far turn, then closed ground willingly. BELLHOUSE vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the last turn, then weakened in the stretch. BUCKHORN prompted the pace early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then gave way in the stretch. GREAT BIG BANG was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. MIAMI MUSIC vied for the lead early, drew off on the backstretch then was headed late and faltered. PRIME PLAYER lacked speed, raced three wide on the second turn, then failed to menace. TRIBUTE was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn then tired and was outrun.
