MORE THAN CANDY set the pace from along the inside, drew clear on the turn and finished under mild urging. FOUR N THREE was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. SCHUYLKILL PUNCH pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. CONFLICTED was void of early speed, raced two wide through the turn then rallied mildly in the lane. SWEETCANDYMAN was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. SEEKING THE CODE pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then faded late. PEAT BAY showed brief speed, raced two wide on the turn, but was never a threat. CAMILLUS DRIVE showed good early speed, raced inside on the turn, then was through after a half. STIMULUS PROGRAM was through early and outrun.
