OVER SPICED stalked the pace from the start, raced along the inside through the second turn, then angled to the outside and rallied late to be up in the final strides. PARISH HILTON set the pace from the start, saved ground through the far turn, held a clear lead in the stretch then was outfinished at the wire. DELIGHTFUL DANA pressed the pace from the start, raced along the two path through the second turn, then weakened late. MY LADY A. P. was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn then made a mild bid late. NORTHERN BERKSHIRE was close up early, raced three side on the second turn, then faded in the stretch. ALL BETS OFF saved ground while trailing throughout.
