DEDE'S MOUSE stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn, then rallied late and drew off under mild urging. OH SO GLITTERY set the pace from the start, saved ground with a clear lead, then was headed on the far turn and gave way in the drive. SISTER SHARON was unhurried early, raced three wide on the last turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. SILLY MONEY was close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn, then lacked a late response. THE AMATEUR pressed the pace from the two path through the far turn, then weakened in the stretch. CASTLE CREEPING was slow early, raced inside on the last turn and failed to menace. FIGHT CAT lacked speed, raced three wide on the far turn and was not a threat. QUEEN'S RULE raced two wide on the second turn and was never a factor. STAND N OVATION saved ground but was outrun.
