### Footnotes

HANDSUP MONEYDOWN stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, reached contention in mid stretch then drew off under urging. MAXIMUM EXCHANGE pressed the pace from the two path, contended on the turn then was outfinished in the final yards. ST. JOHNSWOOD set the pace from the start, raced along the inside on the turn and was headed, then entered into a long drive and gave way. EDGE OF GLORY lacked speed, raced along the three path on the turn and showed little throughout. MAKER OF THE CROWN saved ground while trailing the field. BIG DUTCH broke in the air and lost rider.
