RISKY ALABI stalked the pace from the inside through the turn, angled outward and drew off in the stretch under urging. BILLIONAIRE BOB was close up and three wide on the turn, then rallied late to be up for place. CRAFTY WAYNE was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then found his best stride late. CANE HILL TERRACE pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn and reached contention then weakened in the drive. STAN'S MONEY was slow early, raced four wide on the turn and advanced steadily. MAJI MOTO was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. SLOW NICK C raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. DISTINCT BY DESIGN set the early pace, saved ground and was headed on the turn then faded. D'ARGENTO was close up early, raced inside on the turn then faltered. SUNSHINE MURRAY raced three wide on the turn and was through after a half.
