SLEETINGTEXAS pressured from the three path then moved clear before five furlongs. CANDY BOWL ducked out while breaking in a tangle, was unhurried inside then finished with good energy. CITY CAP stayed out from the rail while making the pace to the stretch then weakened. MILLIONDOLLAR DIVA wasn't far back while well out from the rail and weakened in the lane. DON'T SHORT MARIA wasn't far back inside early then tired. PHRYGIA stayed well out from the rail and failed to menace. LITTLE UNFORGIVEN was outrun inside. TIME BREAK was outrun. GREAT DEFENSE was caught in tight early on the backstretch, stayed outside and was eased up through the stretch. CANDY COTTON lagged badly following a slow break.
