QUICK AND FREE was shuffled back after the break, rallied two wide around the turn then drew clear under mild urging from the inside through the final sixteenth. BLUE LIGHT SPECIAL was never far back inside, came out for the drive, took over after five furlongs but gave way. WILL'S DREAM settled early while not far back inside but lacked a strong closing. PEPPERMENTO was slow early, raced wide around the turn and made up some ground. LITTLEVILLE moved clear after going a furlong, stayed out from the inside and tired in the lane. DISPATCHER was wide around the turn and lacked a rally. GATA TIE ONE ON was no factor. JOE FOR GIN was outrun. BUCKY SPORTFAN showed speed outside then stopped. ONE LESS AFFAIR was outrun. FLASH DRIVE stopped.
