Footnotes

JOANS RHETORIC moved up outside early, moved the three path to the front midway on the turn, moved clear before five furlongs and was kept to urging. I WANT TO TANGO showed speed, moved to the front from the outside leaving the backstretch, stayed out from the rail into the stretch and held the place. SNAFU was slow from the gate then was unhurried early, rallied two wide between rivals on the turn, angled to the rail entering the stretch and gained to the end. LONACONING was slow to settle, raced wide around the turn and outfinished tired ones. PORT ROCK wasn't far back outside to the stretch then stopped. JANET'S WISH came outside on the turn then stopped. KORISSA'S MIRACLE moved to the front from the outside on the backstretch, angled to the inside, steadied nearing the stretch and stopped. SINUS TACH stopped.
