READY OR NOT was unhurried early, raced three wide on the last turn, then angled to the rail and drew off under urging. PERFECT FOOTPRINT was slow early, saved ground on the last turn, then angled to the outside and closed ground willingly. PHILLY BOUND pressed the pace from the three path, reached contention on the second turn, then weakened in the drive. PREACHIN HEAT was never far back, raced along the inside through the second turn, then lacked a late response. POLISHED was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turns then lacked a rally. MISSION GAP vied for the lead from along the inside on the last turn, then faltered in the stretch. FINAL FREEDOM vied for the early lead from along the inside, then dropped back on the second turn and was outrun.
