FASTEST JAMES was rated two wide with the leaders, came out three wide for room approaching the stretch, took over nearing the final furlong and drew out late. MARKET TIDE was slow from the gate, advanced outside on the backstretch, took over three wide before three quarters then couldn't stay late with the winner. NAIF settled between horses, came out wide outside the winner nearing the stretch then flattened out in the drive. GELT moved to a clear lead from the inside before going a quarter then faded on the final turn. IRONHEAD raced three wide with the early pace, opened a clear lead into the far turn then tired. MY SEBY was outrun inside. SENATOR BILL stopped three wide.
