MO WORK FOR TIM vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide and drew off on the turn then was ridden out to the wire. LYRICAL RHYTHMS was close up early, raced four wide on the turn, then was no match for the winner in the stretch. GENTLE RYTHMN pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, then angled outward but lacked a rally late. NUMBER FORTY ONE was unhurried early, raced along the three path on the turn, then found her best stride late. CITY SUNSET vied for the early lead, raced inside through the turn then faded in the stretch. SEXY AND SASSY stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. WHAT PARTNERS DO vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the turn then weakened. IT'S BOLD vied for the lead from the start, raced three wide on the turn, then was through after a half. DIVA'S LAST DANCE saved ground on the turn while trailing throughout.
