HOT TRIAL vied for the lead early, saved ground on the turn, then drew clear in the stretch and finished under urging. CHESTNUT MISSILE pressed the early pace, raced along the two path on the turn then angled outward in the stretch but was no match for the winner. PO MAHINA was never far back, raced inside on the turn, then made a mild bid late. NO PLAN B was close up early, raced two wide on the turn and lacked a late rally. CANIGETAWITNESS pressed the early pace, raced inside on the turn, then faded late. START OUT CALM showed early speed, raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. PEGGY O'Q. was slow early, raced three wide on the turn and was not a threat. DEVIL'S MISTRESS was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn and was not a factor. SPANISH WELLS was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then was through after a half. MENSAJERA showed no speed, raced along the three path through the turn and trailed the field.
