COBRA'S SPOTS was never far back, raced along the inside through the turn, then gained command in the stretch and finished under urging. GRANDMAS PIANO MAN set the pace from along the inside, drew off on the turn then gave way in the stretch. JAKE'S MISSION pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. LUCKY OKIE stalked the early pace, raced along the two path through the turn, then tired from those efforts. MO'S RED DIAMOND was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn and was not a threat. GLITTERICH was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. GLORY BE THY NAME saved ground on the turn but failed to menace. FREEFOURBELLE was through early, raced three wide on the turn, then was outrun.
