SUMMER WAVES bobbled a stride out of the gate then was unhurried, raced two wide around the turn then quickly ran clear from the outside through late stretch. SOSEXc had position, came out three wide nearing the stretch for room, took over entering the final furlong but gave way late. MARINO'S PROMISE broke sharply to make the early pace two wide then weakened. FIRST IN FASHION stayed inside around the turn, came out between rivals in the stretch but lacked a rally. TOOMER'S CORNER made the early pace inside, remained prominent to the stretch then tired. LE SONJA showed speed three wide into the turn then tired. SHE'S A PISTOL was outrun.
