COBALT CHROME set the pace from the start, held a clear lead and saved ground throughout and finished under steady encouragement. NEXT was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly and finished second best. OUTRAGEOUS STORM was never far back, raced four wide through the turn, then made a late bid and weakened. HIT THE BULLS EYE was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then made a mild bid late. OUR MEDALIST was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then faded in the stretch. HE'S A PUCK was void of early speed, raced along the four path through the turn and showed little. WRITTEN RULE stalked the pace early, raced two wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch.
