Footnotes

DETERRENCE set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under urging. BREAK FAST TIFFANY stalked the pace from the two path through the far turn, then rider lost whip at the top of the stretch but made a good effort late. ED'S PRINCESS was never far back, raced along the inside on the last turn then finished well. THE COLOR RED was slow early, raced two wide on the second turn, then made a mild rally late. WICKED QUEEN pressed the pace early, raced three wide on the second turn, then faded in the lane. ECLECTIC was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the last turn and showed little. U. S. S. SEA LION was outrun through the last turn while saving ground and was not a factor. ZAM SLAM broke in the air, then raced three wide on the far turn before being outrun.
