BEST CAMPER stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then rallied in mid stretch and drew clear under strong urging. LUNA ISLAND was close up and three wide through the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. SEARYA was unhurried early, raced two wide on the turn then angled outward at the 1/4 pole and made a mild bid in the lane. LADY BANDINI set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn, then faltered in the stretch. DANCING SPARKS stumbled at the start, then raced two wide through the turn and was not a threat. WATSUP QUEEN was slow early, saved ground on the turn but failed to menace. GALLANT KITTYKAT was close up early, raced along the inside through the turn, then flattened out in the stretch. BURNING HOOFS trailed the field.
