WACKED OUT was never far back, raced along the inside on the turn, then angled to the outside at the 1/4 pole, rallied late then drew off and finished under a hand ride. TEMPESTA TEMPO vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then gave way in the drive. KALIA was close up early, raced two wide through the turn, then tired in the stretch. DUCKHORN'S CHAMP vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then faded in the lane. IMPRESSIVE GAL pressed the pace early, raced three wide on the turn then faltered in the stretch. FIRE AFFAIR lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn, then passed one late. SHESAGAINSTALLODDZ raced along the inside on the turn, was through after a half and outrun.
