DANNY'S FRIEND stalked in the three path, moved to command approaching the stretch and was under urging. TOSSABOUQUET was unhurried inside, came out on the final turn while beginning a rally and finished willingly outside. WAIMEA BAY had early position inside, came out for the drive but lacked a strong closing. DONAMIA was unhurried early then rallied belatedly outside. FULL QUEEN lagged to the stretch then found best stride too late. LIL CAROLINA stayed out from the rail while making the pace for over six furlongs then tired.
