CHARLIE BULL stalked the pace from the two path, reached contention on the second turn then drew clear while under urging. ANGA was unhurried early, saved ground through the far turn then angled outward and rallied to be second best. WESTERN INFLUENCE was close up and two wide through the far turn, then weakened late. CAPE GIRARDEAU was void of early speed, raced along the inside on the last turn while advancing steadily throughout. OUTCLASS set the pace with a clear lead, was headed on the far turn while along the railed then faded in the stretch. ALLEYNES BAY was close up early, raced inside through the second turn then faltered. IMPERIAL ORDER raced in the middle of the pack, was two wide through the far turn and failed to menace. HERR MOZART was close up early, raced inside on the last turn, then failed to sustain a bid. CAPE HARBOUR lacked speed, raced inside on the second turn and showed little throughout. PLEASANTLY GOLD was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn then flattened out. GAMBERONI raced three wide on the second turn and was never a threat. GARP raced two wide on the last turn, was never a factor and was outrun.
